

TK-56RTD Instructions:

Shift Linkage Pin Removal Kit

The tool is hollow to fit over the existing shift lever linkage retention pin. The tool is to allow you to remove a ring of the case from around the pin. We suggest that you don't go deeper than 3/16 of an inch. This will give you a better grip with pliers on the existing straight drift pin to allow it to be removed easier. The replacement pin is much different than the original straight drift or roll pin. It should be installed with the tapered end down into the case and the head end toward the pan. The replacement pin is much easier to remove than either original pin.
